

*Appendix no. 3 to the Rules and Regulations of the International Folklore Festival "Faces of Tradition"*

*Zielona Góra 2021*

In the event of tightening of restrictions pursuant to the spread of SARS-CoV-2 virus, the International Folklore Festival Faces of Tradition 2021 shall assume a hybrid formula.

A hybrid formula of the Festival shall signify realization of the programme of actions without the need to travel to the Festival to Zielona Góra.

Festival agenda:

**1. Band music-dance programme (film displayed on the open-air stage by the City Hall in Zielona Góra on 16-18.09.2021)**

- 1) Approx. 30-minute contest recording (film) with a presentation of music-dance programme of the band which will be subjected to evaluation by the Festival Artistic Committee.
- 2) Presentations displayed before the audience will be limited to the duration of 15 minutes by the Regional Centre for Culture Animation post the band's approval and they will not be assessed by the Festival Artistic Committee.
- 3) Guidelines for recording the films:
  - a) films in \*.mp4 format, in the minimum quality of HD 720p, size not exceeding 1,5GB.
  - b) Please send us single files (one film=one link for download) by means of a service for transferring files (such as WeTransfer.com).

**2. International Singing Contest "Singers in Zielona Góra" (film displayed on the open-air stage by the City Hall in Zielona Góra on 16-18.09.2021)**

- a) The contest is designated for the selected Singers from amongst the Polish and foreign bands.
- b) Each band participating in the Festival is represented by one singer who presents **one song** performed a 'Capella, thus, without any instrumental accompaniment, selected from the traditional repertoire of their region and country.
- c) The song may be related to certain customs, traditions in place or it may be a song that is sung by people on other occasions.
- d) The singer presents individual performance features whilst maintaining the regional style, dialectic characteristics as well as original melody of the song.
- e) The band must send a maximum 4-minute contest recording (film) of sample musical performance of the Singer they selected, in accordance with the requirements specified in art. k) of the hereby paragraph. The duration of the entire show cannot exceed 4 minutes.
- f) The film will be displayed on the open-air stage by the City Hall in Zielona Góra.
- g) Presentations (films) are of contest nature.
- h) Presentations (films) displayed to the public will be assessed by the Festival Artistic Committee.
- i) The winner of the contest will obtain a financial award of 150 EUR.



- j) The Artistic Committee may grant awards in the form of a distinction also to other performers - in-kind prizes.
- k) Guidelines for recording the films:
- films in \*.mp4 format, in the minimum quality f HD 720p, size not exceeding 1,5GB.
  - Please send single files (one film=one link for download) by means of a service for transferring files (such as WeTransfer.com).

**3. International Music Contest “Musicians in Zielona Góra” (film displayed on the open-air stage by the City Hall in Zielona Góra on 16-18.09.2021)**

- a) The contest is designated for bands from amongst the Polish and foreign bands.
- b) The contest may be attended by:
- Folk bands whose instrumental composition and repertoire should be compliant with the traditional patterns of a given region and country; performances of bands occur without participation of soloists-singers,
  - Soloists-instrumentalists who play on traditional instruments, characteristic for a given region and country.
- c) In the framework of the competition the bands as well as the soloists-instrumentalists perform **one composition** selected from the traditional repertoire of their region or country.
- d) The band must send a maximum 6-minute-long contest recording (film) of their musical programme, in accordance with the requirements specified in subpoint (j) of the hereby paragraph. The duration of the entire show cannot exceed 6 minutes.
- e) The film will be displayed on the open-air stage by the City Hall in Zielona Góra.
- f) Presentations (films) are of contest nature.
- g) Presentations (films) displayed before the audience will be assessed by the Festival Artistic Committee.
- h) The winner of the contest will obtain a financial award of 150 EUR.
- i) The Artistic Committee may grant awards in the form of a distinction - in-kind prizes.
- j) Guidelines for recording the films:
- films in \*.mp4 format, in the minimum quality f HD 720p, size not exceeding 1,5GB.

- a) **30-minute-long** film with a programme for the grand finale concert which will be shortened to approx. 2 minutes by the Regional Centre for Culture Animation post approval of the band and subsequently combined with the films about the remaining bands and displayed before the audience in the form of a gala concert online in the city space of Zielona Góra.
- b) Presentations displayed during the Grand Finale gala concert on 18.09.2021 **will not be subjected to** assessment by the Festival Artistic Committee.
- c) Guidelines for recording the films:
  - films in \*.mp4 format, in the minimum quality of HD 720p, size not exceeding 1,5GB.
  - Please send single files (one film=one link for download) by means of a service for transferring files (such as WeTransfer.com).
